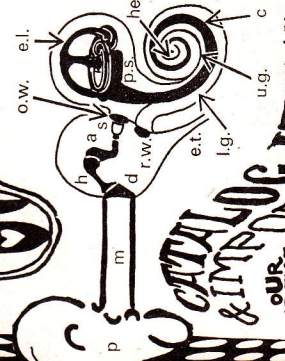

Figure 26. This is a diagrammatic sketch of the human outer, middle, and inner ear. The pinna (p) leads into the meatus (m). The drum (d) separates the outer from the middle ear. The three ossicles, hammer (h), anvil (a), and stirrup (s), lead to the oval window (o.w.). The middle-ear cavity is connected with the cavity of the mouth by the Eustachian tube (e.t.). In the inner-ear cavity lies the fluid-filled ear labyrinth (e.l) with its appendage, the coiled cochlea (c). This is coiled up in a helical space filled with perilymph (p.s.). This space is divided by the cochlear duct into an upper and a lower gallery (u.g., l.g.) which communicate with one another through the helicotrema (he) at the tip of the cochlear duct. The lower gallery is separated from the middle-ear cavity by a membrane covering the round window (r.w.). The cochlear duct, like the ear labyrinth, is filled with endolymph (black).
